HYC Regulations on Social Distancing due to Coronavirus

In order to help maintain Government Guidance on social distancing the following HYC Regulations apply at HYC Havens until further notice:

- 1. Do not gather in groups of more than 6 and maintain 2m or 1m plus mitigation* social distancing, except with members from your household or support bubble, (and with the exception of Clause 4 below)
- 2. Access on boats is permitted and where people are not from the same household or social bubble, the number on board limited to maintain at least 1m plus mitigation* social distancing

 People can also stay overnight away from their homes with members of their own household or support bubble, or with members of one other household (You should continue to maintain at least 1m plus mitigation* social distancing with anyone you do not live with or who is not in your support bubble when doing so)
- 3. Sailing and racing of boats is permitted and where people are not from the same household or social bubble, the number on board limited to maintain at least 1m plus mitigation* social distancing
- 4. Movement and launching/retrieving of boats should be done, where possible to do safely, by a maximum of 6 people or by people from the same household or support bubble. If absolutely necessary, more people can be involved, but only the minimum to safely do the work. At all times 2m or 1m plus mitigation* social distancing shall be maintained, except for people from the same household or support bubble. People not actively involved should not be in the vicinity of this work and keep away.
- 5. Outdoor work activities are permitted providing safely performed by a maximum of 6 people that maintain 2m or 1m plus mitigation* social distancing or by people from the same household or support bubble, (with the exception of Clause 4 above)
- 6. Access to sheds/containers is permitted but should be minimised (Maximum 1 person within each shed/container unless from same household or support bubble)
- 7. Access to the clubhouse is only permitted for use of toilet facilities (Maximum 1 person at a time within the toilet facility area), collection of post, obtaining keys and cleaning
- 8. Avoid passing anyone within corridors or on outdoor walkways
 When accessing the pontoons give way to anyone leaving the pontoons i.e. Leaving a pontoon has priority over accessing a pontoon

* "1m plus mitigation" applies where 2m social distancing cannot be achieved, and requires additional precautionary measures such as avoiding being face to face, use of protective screens and face coverings, and avoiding crowds

These HYC Regulations will be updated as necessary to maintain alignment with the latest Government Guidance on social distancing
