



Notice to Members – Health, Safety & the Environment

Members are recommended to:

- Appraise themselves of Mark Peacock's Guide to the Upper Humber,
- be aware of the likely changes in depth of water in the estuary,
- ensure they carry adequate safety and survival equipment. Life jackets and a VHF must be carried.
- take care on pontoons and when accessing boats.

Also, to review the information contained on the Health & Safety notices in the foyer.

Of particular importance are the following:

- Risk Assessments & Control Measures - which advise safe ways to use equipment and how to carry out tasks safely.
- Safety Data Sheets - which give information about hazardous substances and related first aid advice.
- The location of Fire Equipment, the First Aid Kit and Defibrillator.
- The process to be followed if a defect is discovered or after an Accident or Near miss - this is a feedback process to help reduce future risk.
