

# **HYC Regulations on Social Distancing due to Coronavirus with effect from 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021**

In order to help maintain government rules on social distancing the following HYC Regulations apply at HYC Havens until further notice:

1. **Do not gather outdoors in groups of more than 30 people and maintain 2m or 1m plus mitigation\* social distancing**  
(People from the same household or support bubble do not need to social distance from each other)
2. **Access on boats is permitted and where people are not from the same household or support bubble, the number on board limited to maintain at least 1m plus mitigation\* social distancing**  
**In addition, access below deck & overnight stays away from your primary residence is restricted to a maximum of 6 people or 2 households**
3. Sailing and racing of boats is permitted and where people are not from the same household or support bubble, the number on board limited to maintain at least 1m plus mitigation\* social distancing
4. Movement and launching/retrieving of boats is permitted where people maintain 2m or 1m plus mitigation\* social distancing  
(People from the same household or support bubble do not need to social distance from each other)  
People not actively involved should not be in the vicinity of this work and keep away
5. Outdoor work activities are permitted where people maintain 2m or 1m plus mitigation\* social distancing  
(People from the same household or support bubble do not need to social distance from each other)
6. Access to sheds/containers is permitted but should be minimised (Maximum 1 person within each shed/container unless from same household or support bubble)
7. **Access to the clubhouse is ONLY permitted for use of toilet facilities** (Maximum 1 person at a time within the toilet facility area), collection of post, obtaining keys, displaying race notices and cleaning/essential maintenance  
*(Access to the clubhouse remains limited in this way because the actions/measures needed to manage hospitality or gatherings indoors are very significant & difficult for HYC to achieve)*
8. Avoid passing anyone within corridors or on outdoor walkways  
When accessing the pontoons give way to anyone leaving the pontoons i.e. Leaving a pontoon has priority over accessing a pontoon

\* “1m plus mitigation” applies where 2m social distancing cannot be achieved, and requires additional precautionary measures such as avoiding being face to face, avoiding shouting, using protective screens and face coverings, and avoiding crowds

These HYC Regulations will be updated as necessary to maintain alignment with the latest government rules on social distancing
